EPWORTH MOMENT:

Congratulations to Manning UMC for being a "Sustainer" member of the Bishop's Committee for the "Every Child is a Miracle Financial Campaign." Manning UMC is a "Trailblazer" Church as Epworth expands its mission to help improve the lives of South Carolina's children and families.

The statewide campaign includes a second campus, purchasing and renovating the former Carolina Children's Home in Columbia. New programs creating the new "Institute for Child and Family Wellbeing." This Institute will be comprised of 8-10 centers. Hubs of select centers will be established in each district, and outposts will be established in less populated areas. Centers have opened in the Columbia District, and hubs have opened in the Charleston, Spartanburg, and Greenville Districts, and have opened in March 2021 in the Pee Dee region in the Florence and Marion Districts and with an outpost in Lake City. There are almost 1,000 United Methodist congregations in S.C. and 225,000 United Methodists. Across S.C. there are thousands of children in the foster care system and a shortage of high- quality placements for our children. The current reality is one in five former foster children will:....Become homeless after the age of 18.....At 24, only half will be employed.....Less than 3 percent will have earned a college degree. pregnant by the age of 21.....One in four will have experienced71 percent of women will be post-traumatic stress disorder...twice the rate of U.S. war veterans. Epworth currently has the following programs: The Residential Program The Epworth Center for Family Engagement, The Epworth Center for Independent Living, The Epworth Early Intervention Center, The Epworth Family Care Center, The Epworth Center for Counseling, The Institute for Child and Family Wellbeing

IN NEED: Rev. David McManus and his wife Samantha are seeking in-home care for Samantha's 71-year-old mother Brenda. Brenda had a stroke in November of 2020 and will be living in the parsonage. Brenda's stroke paralyzed her left side, and while she has some mobility, she needs a companion who can perform a variety of daily living tasks. Brenda needs assistance with getting out of bed, getting dressed, toileting, transferring from bed to chair to toilet, doing daily exercises, and walking with her walker. She has balance issues and is stronger some days than others, so we need someone who can help her balance and support her weight without injuring her or themselves. Her companion/sitter will also be responsible for giving her daily medications, preparing simple meals, changing bedding and cleaning Brenda's bedroom as needed. Other light housekeeping may be requested occasionally. We would like a sitter two days a week for approximately 5 hours per day in July but will need a sitter each week day/school day (Sumter School District) beginning August 4th from approximately 7:30 AM to 5 PM.
