From the Pastor

Dear ones,

We are moving into a new year. I am sure that the possibilities of change, renewal, and even of things simply being the same have been on your mind, just as they have mine. There are things that I would like to see change and things that I hope will remain the same. I have often wanted to think of the new year—and even anniversaries—as artificial constructs created by the existence of a paper calendar and not something I should get too worked up about. For instance, my mother died on August 17th of 2008, but she doesn't die every year on that date.

Still, even if there were no calendars, existence on this planet would still mark the cycle. Designed into creation is the passing of seasons, the changing of everything from the branches of trees to the light that filters through them. Just yesterday I had the experience of battling the sun at an intersection where the sun is usually not a problem. I realized the sun only becomes a problem at that intersection during the winter months. So, even if there were no calendar, I would be reminded that time had passed simply by the angle of the sun.

And so it is. Time does pass. And time is marked. God promised it would be so for as long as the earth exists. After the great flood had subsided and his ark had landed on solid ground, Noah made an offering of thanks to the Lord God. You can read that story in Genesis 8:14-22. I want to call your attention to verse 22:

As long as the earth endures, seedtime and harvest, cold and heat, summer and winter, day and night will never cease. (Genesis 8:22 NIV)

There will always be uncertainty in our world. As long as earth exists, seasons and times will change. Imperfect human beings will continue to create imperfect situations, and we will continue to experience both crisis and beauty—often at the same time. I imagine that Noah felt some of that uncertainty as he left the ark. Noah's reaction to that uncertainty was to remember God. Perhaps that would be a good course for us as well. Perhaps, as a new year begins, we should remember that “Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever.” (Hebrews 13:8 NIV)




