#### From the Pastor

"<sup>23</sup> Let us hold unswervingly to the hope we profess, for he who promised is faithful. <sup>24</sup> And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds. <sup>25</sup> Let us not give up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but let us encourage one another-- and all the more as you see the Day approaching." - Hebrews

As conversations about the future of The United Methodist Church are increasing in frequency, I think we should hang onto this scripture. I also think that I should share with you why I am Methodist.

In December of 2006, I was required by the final exam in a seminary course on United Methodist history to answer the question "Why are you United Methodist?". The professor gave us the impression that "because my momma was" would not be a sufficient answer. He was right! Deciding what tradition of the Christ's Church we will commit to is an important decision. Family did play a role but as I matured in my faith, it was the beliefs of the Wesleyan tradition that truly attracted me.

I believe that the theology of the Rev. John Wesley is important and that the revival his preaching and teaching accompanied were used by God to remind the Church that faith is a matter of the heart as well as the mind. I am Methodist because I believe the doctrine of entire sanctification, that we can be perfectly freed from the power of Sin so that we habitually love God and others as easily as we breathe. I believe that Christ died for all, that atonement is not limited. I believe that grace is free to all people, and free from restraint. I believe that all people are able to respond to Christ through the grace that God gives us, and that we must respond. I believe that we can have assurance of our salvation and that God intends for us to be holy and happy—happiness requiring being set apart for God (which is what "holy" means). Wesley's doctrine of Prevenient Grace helped me to understand events and musings in my own life to be the nudging of God toward understanding that sin did not make me happy; and, that Christ died for me. Even me. I am grateful to know that salvation is pardon and power— both forgiveness for sins and freedom from Sin. I'm glad to know that God intends to do good things through me, and through us together. All this is the gift and work of the Blessed Trinity in the love of God the Father, on the merits of Christ's own obedience unto death, through the power of the Holy Spirit.

So, I am Methodist because I presently don't think I could be anything but. This does not explain why I am United Methodist. For that, "because my mama was" will have to do. This is the only branch of Methodism that I have known. Through her people in six difference local churches, The United Methodist Church has loved me, helped me to hear the call of God on my life, prepared me, equipped me, examined me, appointed me, and supported me. For this, I am truly grateful. I am also grateful for your expressions of understanding of the feelings I trusted you with on Sunday, Jan. 22<sup>nd</sup>.

As the calls for disaffiliating or staying are growing louder and louder, hanging on to the words of the scripture above will do us good. We keep our hope in Christ. We keep encouraging one another in love and service to Christ and our neighbors. We keep meeting together, especially when we feel discouraged, remembering Christ and his goodness toward us; so that, when the time comes to decide if this local church will leave, we decide together in love.
